WINEMAKING

The grapes, coming from our property Quinta da Cabreira in the Douro Superior sub-region, were taken to the winery in plastic boxes and rigorously inspected on a sorting table on arrival. The grapes were then completely destemmed and slightly crushed. After this, the must was transferred to temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGEING

12 months in French oak barrels.

TASTING

Colour: Deep violet.

Nose: Very expressive aromas, displaying vibrant berry fruit notes perfectly combined with subtle hints of fresh spices.

Palate: Charming on the palate. Berry fruit flavours, great volume, solid structure and velvety tannins. The finish is perfectly balanced, fresh and long.
