WINEMAKING

The grapes, coming from our property **Quinta da Cabreira** in the **Douro Superior** sub-region, were taken to the winery in plastic boxes and rigorously inspected on a sorting table on arrival. The grapes were then completely destemmed and slightly crushed. After this, the must was transferred to temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGEING

In French oak barrels for about 12 months.

TASTING

Colour: Deep purple.

Nose: Intense aromas of berry fruit well balanced with fresh notes of cocoa and delicate hints of violets.

Palate: Elegant beginning leading to a well structured wine, with great volume and smooth, finely textured tannins. Everything is in perfect harmony with vibrant berry fruit flavours. Fresh and lingering finish.
